Subject: Certification of ALE OmniSwitch Products

The Common Criteria for Information Technology Security Evaluation (CC) has adopted the Common Criteria Recognition Arrangement (CCRA) to ensure consistency in the establishment of security profiles, evaluation of products, and issuance of Common Criteria certification across the CCRA signatory organizations. Common Criteria certifications issued by one signatory of the CCRA are recognized by all signatories of the CCRA without the need for additional testing.

Bundesamt für Sicherheit in der Informationstechnik (BSI) is a signatory to the Common Criteria Recognition Agreement (CCRA). BSI recognizes the Common Criteria certifications issued by another CCRA signatory as equivalent to the certifications that are provided by BSI.

The ALE OmniSwitch models OS6250, OS6350, OS6450, OS6860, OS6865, OS6900, OS9900, OS10K have received Common Criteria EAL2 certification issued by CCRA signatory Swedish Certification Body for IT Security.
